- ✓ Raise awareness of autism amongst health and care professionals and generic community services to encourage better understanding and breakdown barriers encountered by people who have autism.

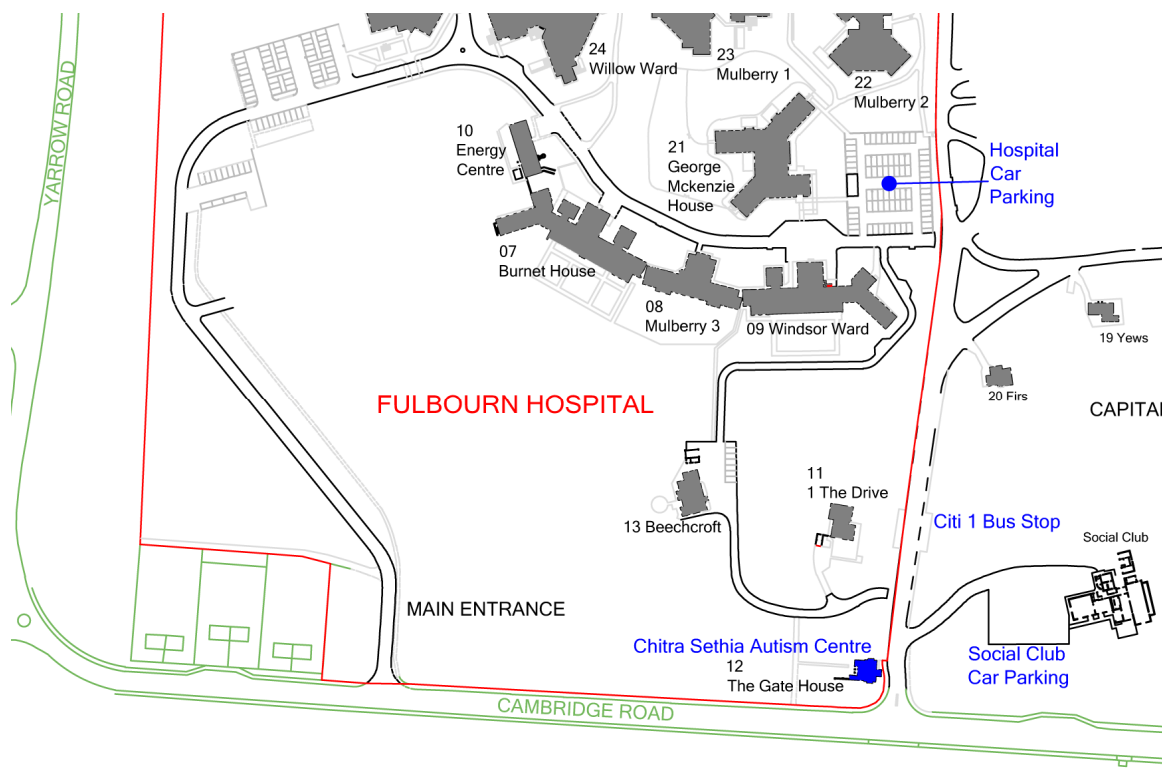
