Education, Health and Care Plans (EHCP) and statements should be reviewed each year. It allows you, your child and the school to discuss progress, suggest changes to the statement or EHCP and look at future requirements. All this will be explained and more during this session.

Schools can support the majority of pupils with special educational needs and disabilities without the need for a Statement or Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP). This seminar will explain how they do this and the law and guidance they follow when they do so.

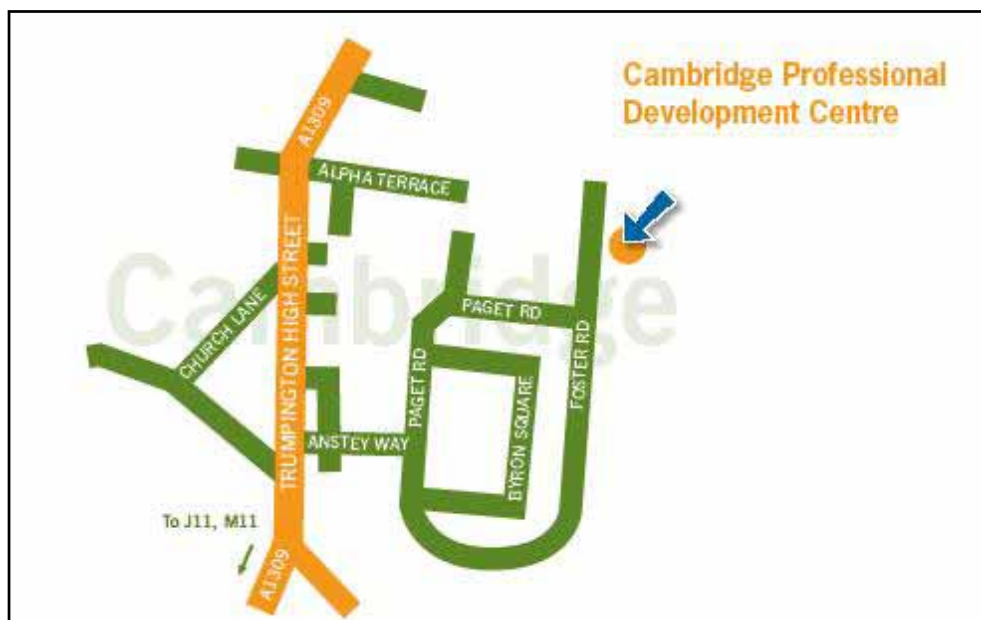

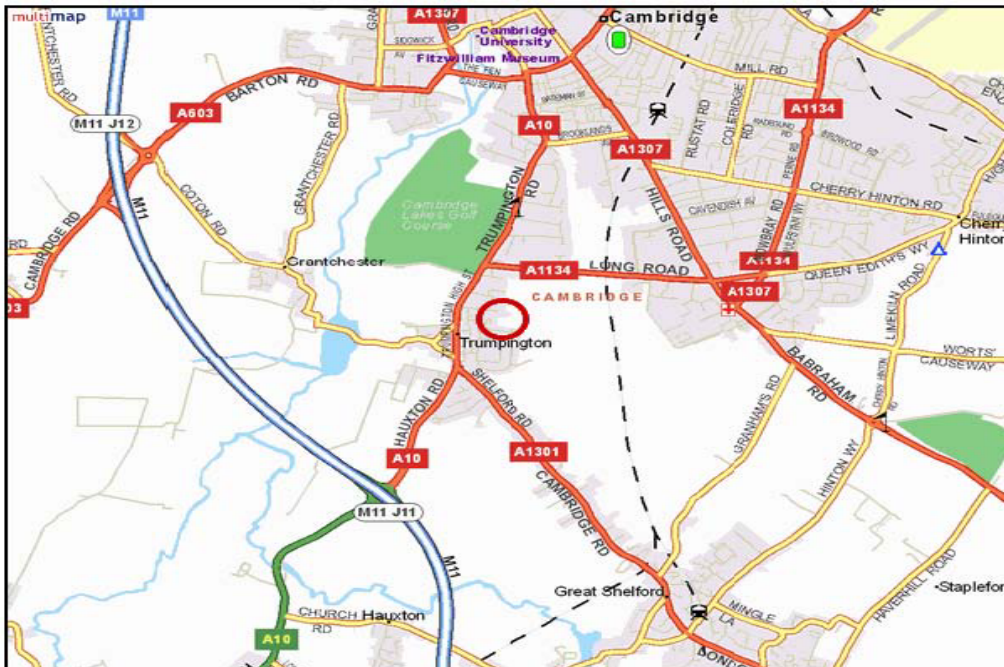
